Safety is our main concern for all students at Washington. Please note these important dismissal procedures for the 2019-20 school year!

#### **Dismissal Times:**

2:45pm—Kindergarten ONLY

2:55pm—Early Bus Riders

2:57pm—Walkers/Bike Riders

3:00pm—All other students

3:05pm—Late Bus Riders

**Kindergarten Parents:** Kindergarten students are released at 2:45pm to avoid the rush of older students exiting the building. Parents may pick up their child at Door 12 (East facing door on northeast corner of the building. Enters East doors of A-Hall.)

**Walkers:** Walkers may exit out any door when dismissed. However, they are to wait and cross the road with one of our crossing guards.

Parent Pick Up Lane:

- The parent pick up lane is located on the northeast parking lot.
- Vehicles will enter from Cunningham Street.
- STUDENTS will be waiting for parents to get to the FRONT of the pick up line.

  Students will not be permitted to enter a vehicle until their ride is in the front of the line.
  - Students will not be permitted to enter a vehicle until their ride is in the front of the line and has pulled up to the designated pickup area. (This will eliminate students from weaving through cars.)
- STUDENTS will be held in a designated area as they exit the building at dismissal (Near the bike racks outside East doors of A-Hall.
   They will stay until their pick up vehicle is at the front of the line.)
- PARENTS: Please do not pass cars in front of you.
- PARENTS: Please expect to pull into the staff parking lot if your child is not present when you reach the front of the line.
- Please be patient as we all work together to create a safe environment!!
