

### IAR TESTING

As the end of the school year approaches, grades 3, 4, & 5 will begin the state mandated Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) testing. (Formally known as PARCC) <u>Important dates below:</u>

#### March 30 - Washington IAR Kick-off Assembly March 31 - April 6 Testing Days

Students will be tested in the subjects of Mathematics & English Language Arts.

It is important to encourage your student to do their very best on the tests. Our school has done well in years past and would love to continue this pattern.

How can you help prepare your student? - Set an early bedtime to obtain a good night's rest.

- Provide a balanced breakfast the morning of testing.

- Encourage your child to do their best on the testing, but not to worry too much.

- Remind your student to ask their teacher questions if they do not understand the testing directions.

Friend Watch is an online messaging system that allows students/parents/guardians to send anonymous messages to school administrators and counselors and inform them of possible bullying incidents involving students both in and out of the school setting.
