#### Maintenance Report

Marion High School ADA Renovations Phase 6 - Concrete work has been completed with minor items to repair. Handrails are scheduled for installation the week of 7-31. Sandblasting at the High School Stairs is complete with painting to follow. Adams was scheduled to start sandblasting yesterday (Monday), but was cancelled due to the threat of rain. It should start today (Tuesday) weather permitting. The contractor states that both will be completed by 7-28.

Marion Parking Lot Renovations Lincoln and Jefferson - Lincoln East side concrete parking lot has been poured with striping to follow. West asphalt area has been paved. East side of this area will be sealed and striped along with South parking area and West area. Concrete repairs have been completed at Lincoln. Seal, striping, and parking bumps to start as early as tomorrow (

## Maintenance Report (con't)

Marion Parking Lot Renovations Lincoln and Jefferson - (Wednesday). Jefferson parking area on the East side is poured with Change Order work being prepared for pouring this week. Additional downspout drain piping has been completed. Striping, sign installation and parking bumpers to be installed the work of 7-24.

**Jefferson Roof Replacement -** 100% of EPDM Roofing has been installed except for Roof Area D which will be completed along with new work going on with the Media Center. This will allow for a much better tie-in. Soffit and mansard work is ongoing. EFIS work, windows, and final detailing will be completed by 7-28. Sheet metal work is ongoing and will be completed in the playground areas prior to the start of school with other areas following closely behind.

Jefferson Pre-K Window and Door Replacement - Wood doors and frames are installed. Painting is complete with minor touch up. Interior Aluminum Doors to start installation today (Tuesday) and take about 3-4 days. Exterior Aluminum Doors should arrive 8-11 and take about a week to install. This will be coordinated with the school so it will not interfere with daily operations. Windows are backordered and waiting for shipping confirmation. This work will also be coordinated with the school so it will not interfere with daily operations.

Washington HVAC Replacement - All ceiling and demolition work has been completed. New grid in Cafeteria has been installed. Duct painting has started in the Cafeteria along with the wall areas. Temporary cooling to be installed in Cafeteria to allow painting and ceiling work to continue. Lights are being installed in Cafeteria. Lights are scheduled to start in Media Center on 7-18. Duct work in this area is continuing. Some duct insulation is completed along with structural reinforcement. New gypsum board installation is being finished in Cafeteria and Media Center. Ceiling work in Media Center to start this week. Media Center windows have been measured and are scheduled for installation. Waiting for glass shipping confirmation for Marion Glass. Electrical work for Media Center RTU is to start today (Tuesday). Gas line will be last item completed.

Washington & Jr. High New Fire Alarm Systems - Washington and Jr High have 95% of all new devices installed with wiring run to new panel locations. Tech Electronics will be on site at the Jr. High tomorrow (Wednesday) to start checking out the new system. As soon as it is operational the old will be torn out. Some of this work may be completed on second shift after school starts. Note at Washington: The existing Fire Alarm System will remain operational until all new components arrive from the supplier. Any work required after school starts will be completed by the contractor on the second shift.

Marion Jr. High Phase 2 HVAC - HVAC work continues. Insulation of piping and duct in Cafeteria to be finished this week. The control wire is 90% complete. Door frames have been demolished and new ones installed in about 90% of the West building. Door frame painting will be completed on the second floor of West Building with wall touch up to follow. Exterior door installation started 7-10-23 and 3 have been completed in the East Building. The Kitchen exterior door and frame should be installed today (Tuesday), 2 Office Entry Aluminum Door Systems are scheduled for 7-20, followed by South door and finishing up with 2 doors remaining Southeast side. All interior glass is scheduled to arrive on 7-27 for immediate installation in the Library and Office. Second floor ceiling grid, ceiling tiles, duct work, piping, insulation, and lights have been installed excluding 3 new switches which are scheduled to arrive on 7-20. 4 new RTU's will be installed starting on 7-19 or 20. This should take about 2 to 3 days. The wiring will be completed at this time also. Electronic door access systems will be installed the week of 7-24. Note: All the door and frame replacement will not be completed this year due the late delivery of the doors last year which did not allow any to be installed last year and this was a 2-year project from the start. We had hoped that they all could be installed

## Maintenance Report (con't)

Marion Jr. High Phase 2 HVAC - this summer. We will have 35 doors and frames in the East and West buildings to install. Installed this year there have been ten aluminum exterior doors and 152 interior doors installed. There was also the addition of the two Band Room RTUs that are on order and will be installed as soon as they arrive. The delivery date is unknown at this time. The installation of those units will be coordinated with the school so it will not interfere with daily operations.

Marion Jr. High Exterior Renovations - EFIS work is 100% complete with minimal flashing work to be completed. South and West side of 2 story building has been tuckpointed and washed. The North side will be tuckpointed with cleaning to follow this week along with the East side. 1 story work still to be completed is East side with small section on South area of the 2 story above the cafeteria. Waterproofing will be the last step of this work. Estimated completion to be 7-28 weather permitting. All grinding will be completed prior to the start of school if unable to finish prior to school starting with just tuckpointing and waterproofing to be completed on the one-story East wall.

Jefferson Media Center Renovations - Interior demolition work is completed. The walls have been infilled and drywall has been hung. Mud and tape should be finished by the end of today (Tuesday) with painting to follow in both rooms (Media Center and Classroom). All ceiling work and electrical should be completed next week with flooring to be installed by 8-2. At that time or by the end of that week, both spaces should be available for school personnel to occupy. Note: This is only the interior work and the exterior work has started, but will continue into the school year. The project is scheduled to be substantially complete by September 1, 2023, so any work to be completed after the start of school will be coordinated with the school so it will not interfere with daily operations.

## **Assistant Superintendent Report**

Mrs. Watts reported Summer School concluded on June 23. There were 261 elementary students, 54 MJHS students and 126 MHS students enrolled. Both teachers and students reported another positive experience. She announced new and returning student registration is Thursday, August 3 and encouraged everyone to register their students.
