**Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 5:32 p.m.

**Closed Session**

**Motion #1:** The Board voted 6-0 to enter into closed session at 5:34 p.m. for the purpose of Personnel, the purpose of the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees of the public body or legal counsel for the public body, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee of the public body or against legal counsel for the public body to determine its validity; Litigation, when an action against, affecting or on behalf of the particular public body has been filed and is pending before a court or administrative tribunal, or when the public finds that an action is probable or imminent, in which case the basis for the finding must be recorded and entered into the minutes of the closed meeting and the Selection of a Person to Fill a Public Office, as public office is defined in the Open Meetings Act, or to fill a vacancy in a public office when the public body is given the power to appointment under law or the discipline, performance or removal of the occupant of a public office when the public body is given power to remove the occupant under law.

**Example of Educational Excellence**

Dr. Gabriele Farner, MHS Business teacher, highlighted the business department by sharing a slideshow of an educational research project her business classes are conducting called The Goldfish Project. Her business students are researching to see which goldfish cracker flavor is Marion's favorite. One of Dr. Farner's students, Kali Wallace, helped present the project to the school board. Kali emphasized the many skills the students have gained during their participation in the project such as how to research, conduct assessments and surveys, and to create campaigns through social media. Kali also noted that the project has taught the students to reach out and engage with different people, groups and businesses in the community to help promote their project. While partnering with Pure Pet, Granny Puckett's, Black Diamond, the elementary schools in Marion and the Marion City Hall the students have packed over 10,000 samples to pass out to conduct surveys. After voting closes on April 12th, Dr. Farner's students will compile their findings into a report and share the results through social media.

Hayden Little, Joshua McDougall, Jack Tate and Andre Jones broke the 4x400m Relay record with a time of 3:36.02.



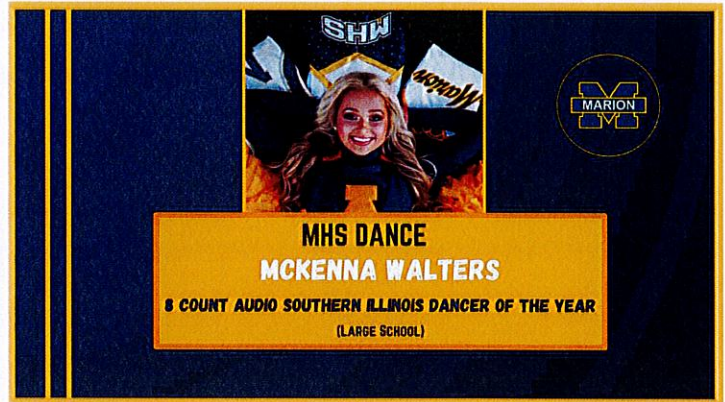





