Food Service Annual Report

Unit #2 Food Service Director, Kyle Hartwell, presented the annual food service report. He reported the food service staff served a total of **265,586** meals to students and staff during the 2019-2020 school year. Due to the last quarter of the school year switching to remote learning, meals were made available to Unit #2 students by a Grab & Go plan. A total 28,221 meals were picked up or delivered to our students. He thanked everyone for their efforts in making this program a success.

Maintenance Report

Buildings

Lincoln Roof project is 90% complete – some gutter and flashing work still needs to be completed. The parking lot and a piece of the yard was damaged during this process and will be scheduled for repair. Wilson Gym and JH West Gym wood floors have been sealed, JH East, Washington and Adams are still being scheduled.

Custodial

Custodians are busy deep cleaning, scrubbing and waxing all our schools as well as keeping the areas sanitized that are being used by staff or contractors.

Grounds

Mowing crew continues to work on all our grounds with the mowing, trimming trees and landscaping areas.

Sports Complex

Complex crew is working to keep our grounds and sports fields manicured, watered when needed as well as fertilized. They help with tree trimming throughout our district along with shaping up all of our landscape areas, shrubbery, mulch and rock beds.

Treasurer's Report

The District is 100% of the way through the fiscal year as of June 30, 2020. The Education Fund expenditures are at 98.31% and Operations and Maintenance Fund expenditures are at 88.79%. Expenditures for all district funds are at 97.35%.
